Camilla Prini Gallery is pleased to present, from March 12 to April 17, 2026, the first solo exhibition in Italy by Australian artist Marisa Veerman.

The exhibition features thirteen previously unseen photographs, where embroidery serves as a precious element, weaving the intricate textures of this extraordinary artist's inner world.

Following her remarkable debut at Roma Arte in Nuvola 2025, the gallery consolidates its exclusive partnership with Veerman by dedicating this significant monograph to her at its Milan location during the month dedicated to Photography.

Marisa Veerman (b. 1977) is an Australian artist living and working in Brisbane. Her practice stems from a poetic union of photography and embroidery, born from reflections on emotion, childhood, and the preciousness of the human soul.

With a professional background in textile Visual Merchandising for renowned brands, Veerman's experience deeply informs her aesthetic, leading her to spontaneously fuse photography with the tactile world of textiles. In her process, she carefully stages each scene—using models, costumes, and long exposure times—to capture images of melancholic and ethereal beauty. The embroidery and beadwork that embellish the surface add a physical, tactile dimension, while a thin layer of varnish binds the elements together, resulting in a visual style that blurs the line between painting and photography.

Marisa Veerman has exhibited widely across Australia, the United States, and Denmark. She has received prestigious accolades, including the 2019 Rotary Art Award for mixed media and the 2024 Clayton Utz Art Award.

Camilla Prini Gallery is a contemporary art gallery based in Milan, focusing on painting, photography, and sculpture characterized by a figurative style. The gallery explores the relationship between artwork and inhabited spaces.

Originally founded as Arte in Salotto, the gallery maintains an intimate, domestic approach as its signature curatorial language. In addition to its exhibitions, Camilla Prini Gallery offers bespoke consultancy services for artwork selection and professional interior placement advice.
