Camilla Prini Gallery is pleased to announce the opening of DOUBLE TAKE, a group exhibition that on September 23, 2026 brings together nine voices of contemporary figurative research at its Brera venue: Manù Brunello, Paola Cassola, Marcello Chiarenza, L'orma, Bérengère Lux, Onirika, Giulio Rigoni, Héloïse Rival and Marisa Veerman. Most are artists the gallery has worked with since it opened in 2020, alongside a few exciting new additions.

The exhibition's title — which in English refers both to the act of looking twice and to the sudden perception of a double, an echo, an unexpected resemblance — is also the key to reading the project. DOUBLE TAKE stems from the idea that a work of art doesn't always exhaust its meaning in itself, but can find completion, tension or revelation in dialogue with another: with itself, reflected and multiplied, but also with the gaze of another artist who, from a different perspective, shares the same question.

This led to the choice of building the show as a series of encounters in pairs: artists placed in dialogue whose work — though created independently — reveals affinities of technique, material or vision. In ceramics, for instance, Héloïse Rival's pieces engage with those of Bérengère Lux, bringing into focus two distinct ways of conceiving the same material. In another room, Manù Brunello's geishas are reflected in Paola Cassola's mirrors: different surfaces that nonetheless share a goldsmith's attention to detail, complementing one another in intent.

With this approach, the gallery moves away from the traditional sequence of individual works to propose a layout conceived as a constellation of dialogues: each piece becomes a node in a wider network, inviting visitors to discover unexpected connections.

True to its vocation as a "cultural salon," Camilla Prini Gallery reaffirms with DOUBLE TAKE its commitment to quality figurative art capable of engaging with the intimate, domestic space that has always distinguished the gallery — offering the public and collectors the chance to discover, in a single exhibition, the richness and variety of nine distinct artistic paths, united by one subtle thread of connections.
